FIRST AID

Directions For Use:

To clean stainless steel citrus spray tank after use of copper or other corrosive materials, first wet surface with water, then wipe *Tank & Surface Cleaner* on tank with a sponge or rag. USE PLASTIC GLOVES AND SAFETY GLASSES WHEN HANDLING. Wait approximately five minutes and then rinse thoroughly with clean water. Stain removing action starts immediately. Also effective for rust stains on concrete and equipment. Might need to allow more time before rinsing. Helps form inhibiting compound. Avoid contact with chlorine bleach. *Tank & Surface Cleaner* will help preserve tanks and related equipment.
